- programming concept and solution for rapid Excel's menu development

Where the idea came from?

- the solution is based on famous John Walkenbach's MenuMaker

What is different?

- I added code for pasting your own images to your menu items and code for using comboboxes in your menu

- I also added code for manipulating (disabling/enabling) default items of menu bar.

Why shall I use it?

I say you, why I use the concept. I am independent Excel developer struggling with the lack of time.

I need to develop solution as quick as possible and the same stands for changes management.

And one of the most time consuming activities is just menu creation.

On the other side, you can just imagine, how surprised will be your clients (boss, CEO,CFO, colleagues...), if you can incorporate their suggestions concerning menu changes "on the fly" ?

No need for visiting workshops, setting workteams, appointing team leaders, evolving project schedules...

Something they know very well whenever they need a small change in companies information systems.

How to use it?

Read the comments in first row of sheet called **MenuSheet**.

I use the solution in the way I copy sheet called "**MenuSheet**" and all codes to my projects and set within **Workbook_Open** event the call of routine for making menu.

Of course I also set within **Workbook_BeforeClose** event the call of routine for deleting menu.

I recommend you to delete the buttons "**Make menu**" and "**Delete menu**" after successful testing period as well.

And of course hide your sheet "**MenuMaker**".

The price?

Nothing at all. You can use it without limitation. If you like the concept, just send an email to the address

What to do, if I do not like the solution?
